QUALIFICATIONS FOR MEMBERSHIP: Men and women over twenty-one years of age, one or more of whose ancestors lived in Indiana in the year 1830 or earlier, shall be eligible to membership. Proof of eligibility shall be made by written application, verified by affidavit signed by the applicant and established by reference to authentic history, church, burial or other private records, public records and such other documents as the board of governors shall by general regulations prescribe.

(Applications should be made in duplicate and sent to the Registrar. If eligibility is claimed through more than one line of descent, use additional applications. Fill out the genealogical blanks below as far back as the ancestor through whom claim is made.)
